Commencing in 2012, the regional community trainers will:

- Assist in the development and delivery of on-site training workshops in your region
- Provide follow-up support to participants in the training program as required
- Identify potential training sites

We will train you in our training methods before you begin and initially you will work in partnership with RNLD's linguist.

The number of weeks of work per year will depend on the training needs in your region. Travel to training locations and accommodation expenses will be met by the RNLD.
